This COVID-19 has cancelled a lot of our tours. Read your email and newsletters for what is cancelled.

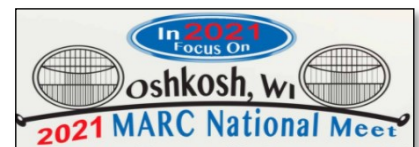
